College of Nursing started in the year 2008 aims at preparing Nurses of High Professional standards with a sense of discipline, responsibility and integrity through excellent teaching learning facilities. The college is equipped with the modern facilities, excellent infrastructure and highly qualified faculty to conduct graduate and post graduate Nursing Programmes. Students are offered with an all-round development opportunity through class room teaching, Laboratory practices, various clinical experiences, conferences, seminars, symposiums and educational visits as per the curriculum requirements along with co-curricular and extracurricular activities.



BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (B.Sc NURSING - 4 Years)

B.Sc Nursing is an undergraduate programme that prepares graduates to afford great carrier opportunities and high salary options. It is a pre requisite for care provider, teacher, researcher and administrative roles in various health care settings. The annual intake is 100.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or Examination equivalent there to as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Candidate should have separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50 % marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together.
- 2. Candidate belonging to SC/ST category needs only a pass in the qualifying examination. However the rules and regulations stipulated by the Government of Kerala and Kerala University of Health Sciences from time to time will be applicable.
- 3. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside Kerala State shall produce equivalency of qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health Sciences along with the applications.
- 4. Candidate shall be medically fit.
- 5. Applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31,12,2025, Upper age limit is 35 years as on 31,12,2025,

SELECTION

- 1. Candidates to 50% of seats for BSc Nursing Course will be filled up by the Govt. from state merit and the remaining 50% of seats will be filled up by the management of the college of which 35% of total seats will be filled up from the rank list for management quota and 15% of the total seats will be filled up by the management from Non Resident India NRI quota rank list.
- 2. Applications will be received **online** only for the management and NRI quota seats and separate rank list will be prepared for each quota. Any other mode of submission of application shall not be entertained and will be rejected.
- 3. Separate Rank list will published in the website for both management and NRI quota seats prepared on the basis of marks obtained by candidates for Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together at the final year of the qualifying examination. Incase of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks in Biology/ Chemistry/Physics/total marks in the qualifying examination (Plus One and Plus Two together) / percentage of marks in English / age of the candidate/alphabetical order of the name respectively will be placed higher in the ranking.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION FOR THE BSc NURSING COURSE

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Printout of the online application along with necessary documents should reach the Office of the College of Nursing within the prescribed date.
- 2. Incomplete and incorrect application will be rejected.
- 3. If false statements in the application are detected on further scrutiny, admission will be cancelled and fees paid will not be refunded.
- 4. The right of admission is reserved to the concerned competent authority.
- 5. Prescribed fee should be paid at the time of admission.
- 6. Application fee once paid will not be refunded.
- 7. Admission is provisional and subject to the approval of the concerned competent authority.
- 8. The following original documents are required to be submitted at the time of admission along with 3 sets of xerox copies.
 - a. Certificates of Qualifying Examinations
 - b. SSLC
 - c. Transfer Certificate.
 - d. Conduct certificate.
 - e. Certificate of Medical Fitness / Physical fitness and vaccination certificate from authorized Government Medical Officer.
 - f. Migration certificate (Only if necessary).
 - g. Equivalency certificate (Only if necessary).
 - h. Caste certificate (for SC/ST candidates).
 - i. Nativity certificate.
 - j. Aadhaar Card
 - k. 5 passport size and 3 stamp size colour photos in white background with name and date of birth.
- 9. Additional Documents to be Submitted by the NRI Candidates along with Application.
 - a. Sponsorship certificate on Rs. 200 stamp paper attested by notory.
 - b. Copy of relevant pages of the Passport containing Visa Details attested by Embassy / Gazetted Officer
 - c. Employment Certificate (with salary) of the Sponsor attested by Embassy.
 - d. Relationships Certificate from Revenue Authorities
- 10. The students of B.Sc Nursing are required to refer to rules and regulations of Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council, Indian Nursing Council, Kerala University of Health Sciences and Government of Kerala issued from time to time.
- 11. Admission is made only to the First year of the course and not directly to any higher class. Application for admission to higher classes or for migration to other colleges will not be entertained.
- 12. Students are required to submit Application for Hostel Admission at the time of interview. Admission to the hostel will be as per the provision of statutory body.

FEE STRUCTURE

- 1. Students are liable to pay the tuition fee and special fee as fixed by the Government of Kerala at the time of admission.
- 2. The tuition fee and special fee for the first year has to be paid at the time of Admission. The tuition fee and special fee for subsequent years has to be paid before the fourth working day of the beginning of each academic year. Fine will be levied from defaulters who are not paying the fee in the prescribed time period.
- 3. Fee for College Union, Sports day, Cultural day, etc. has to be paid separately.
- 4. Hostel fee has to be paid at the beginning of each academic year or paid monthly before 5th of each month.
- 5. Mess fee in the hostel has to be paid before the 5th day of each month.
- 6. Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court."

DRESS CODE

- 1. The students attending classes and assigned duty shall wear the prescribed uniform.
- 2. Students shall wear neat and decent dress during off duty hours inside the campus.
- 3. Students shall not use excess jewellery.
- 4. Male students have to do proper hair cut and shaving.

GENERAL RULES

The parents and guardians are advised to go through the rules and regulations of the College & Hostel and co-operate with the Management, Principal and staff members to maintain peaceful atmosphere in the college.

- 1. Students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the Institution.
- 2. Students are expected to maintain highest standards in their academic, professional and private life.
- 3. No student should stand or loiter about in the corridors during class hours.
- 4. Students are forbidden from writing on walls, desks & on other pieces of furniture, affixing posters, display materials like flex boards and other articles on the walls of the college building etc. They may however do so in the space allotted specifically for the purpose.
- 5. Ragging is strictly prohibited. "If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if explanation is not found satisfactory the authority would expel him/her from the institution". Ragging In any form will be dealt as criminal offense. All students must upload an Anti Ragging undertaking at the website www.antiragging.in and submit the hard copy on admission in the college.
- 6. Undesired activities such as using vulgar language and indulging in violence are strictly prohibited.
- 7. The use, possession or distribution of any type of drugs, alcohol and tobacco is strictly prohibited within the college and hostel premises.
- 8. Use of mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the Classroom, Laboratory and Clinical Area.
- 9. Students should be utmost regular and punctual in their class room session, practical, field work sessions and other academic exercises. They are required to attend all the allotted working periods in each of the prescribed subjects.
- 10. No student will be admitted to the class room unless he/she is well equipped with the required instruments and necessities as and when instructed by the concerned faculty members.
- 11. Students should complete their academic requirements in the same year before the succeeding examination.
- 12. Proper and prior permission must be obtained from Principal before organising and conducting tours, picnic or other group activities.
- 13. Students should refrain damaging college property.
- 14. In case of any breakage/loss of hospital or college property, it shall be made good promptly, either individually or collectively.
- 15. The management, following due enquiry procedure, has the right to expel any student whose conduct and character are not satisfactory.
- 16. Any student acting in violation of any of the rules and regulations of the campus or found disturbing the peace in campus as well as off campus will be prosecuted by the head of the institution reserving the right to suspend/dismiss the student without any explanation.
- 17. Student communications intended for higher authorities must be submitted through the Principal.
- 18. Students should wear their Identity Cards always.
- 19. Student using own vehicles should get permission from the concerned authorities by submitting copy of license and vehicle registration certificates.
- 20. Certificates will be issued only on the specified days.
